Terms and Conditions for Schools and Local Authority groups

- The participants agree to abide by such regulations as Black Rock Outdoors and its instructors may consider advisable in order to secure the safety and comfort of all participants.
- Participants understand that Black Rock Outdoors is under no liability whatsoever in respect of personal injury or loss or damage to personal property sustained by participants. You are advised to take out personal cancellation, accident or property insurance before you arrive.
- Black Rock Outdoors will accept the responsibility for the provision of the Outdoor Activities concerned. Instructors will be suitable qualified and experienced. Sessions will be run in accordance with National Governing Body recommendations and the terms of the Adventure Activities Licensing Authority certificate.
- It is understood that school staff will accompany each group and that they will be responsible for the behavior and supervision of participants. School staff must ensure that all behave in an appropriate manner and are suitably dressed.
- School staff will have to hand medical and consent forms of students and will advise Black Rock Staff of any relevant medical or behavior concerns.
- Black Rock Outdoors will supply information on qualifications etc if required.
- Deposits and payments are normally made in advance. Where an agreement is made for payment by invoice, payment will be due within 14 days of the booked session or activity day.
- If a school or organization cancels a booked session with less than seven days notice, they would be liable for a cancellation fee of 40%. If cancelled with less than 24 hours notice, the School or Authority would be liable for the full cost.
