Hazard

Injury to pupil, school staff and any observer through equipment failure, structure failure, the weather or through the manner in which the session is run.

Control Measures

Acquire confirmation that all the following are to be met:

- The Activity Provider is AALA licensed where appropriate.
- The Instructing staff hold suitable qualifications and are sufficiently experienced.
- The Provider's operating procedures meet the standards and requirements of National Governing Bodies.
- All equipment is of a serviceable standard, meets the Nationally accepted standard and is regularly inspected.
- Alternative arrangements will be made should the weather be poor.
- Instructor / student ratios will meet National Governing Body standards.

Ensure

- School staff are available to support instructors in matters of discipline and general group control.
All participants and supervising staff listen carefully and understand and follow all instructions.
- Students are adequately supervised during activities and periods when they are between activities.
- Students are suitably prepared with regard to expectation and equipment and clothing required.
