



Black Rock Terms and Conditions

Terms and Conditions - Adult and Children groups

(This includes; corporate groups, stag/hen parties, birthday parties and other bookings)

- Participants must agree to abide by such regulations as Black Rock Outdoors and its instructors may consider advisable to make in order to secure the safety and comfort of all course participants.
- Those involved must understand that Black Rock Outdoors is under no liability whatsoever in respect of personal injury or loss or damage to personal property sustained by participants. You are advised to take out your own personal cancellation, accident or property insurance before you arrive.
- Participants must ensure that Black Rock Outdoors is made aware of any relevant medical conditions prior to the activity.
- Participants must dress appropriately for activities, this information can be found on the website on the [Links and Downloads](#) page.
- Parents or supervisors of children groups are welcome to watch but must not get involved with the safe running of the session. The control of the session must remain with Black Rock staff. If the session is at Cobbs Cross Farm, all must remain in the appointed area and parents must supervise children and ensure that they keep within the designated area and follow all instructions.
- Children's groups must be supervised by an adult who has taken responsibility for those participants. They are to ensure that children are suitably behaved and responding to instruction.
- Participants should not be under the influence of alcohol or other substances. Black Rock reserves the right to turn away any participant who does not behave accordingly.
- Bringing dogs along is not encouraged, they can be disruptive to the running of activities. Dogs that do attend must be on a lead at all times and not in the vicinity of activities.
- Provisional bookings can be made by email or telephone. A non returnable deposit is required to confirm the booking. Full payment is then due no later than the day of the booked session.
- All payments can be made online by Credit or Debit card, or by Bank Transfer (account details will be on the invoice) Cheques can be accepted as a deposit. For the final payment, cheques can only be accepted if sent ten days in advance of the booked activity.
